BOAT TRIP TO BUNCE ISLAND

- *Bunce Island (1668 – 1807) was famous to be a major European commercial fort built during the slave trading era. It was a meeting place for European traders and African merchants. From the point 50,000 slaves women, children and aged men were transited to the Americas.*

Trading of slaves, gold, ivory, and cane wood was very famous during the 1800's, and a large number of slaves sent to South Carolina and Georgia were traded on this island. See and feel the Island by touching the canons yourself.
